48 hours <i>Forecast 1 of 7</i>	Tuesday, January 9 th 4:00am	Winter storm watch in effect from Wednesday evening through Thursday evening. Snow likely. Snow accumulations 2-3 inches. Highs in the low 30s. Chance of precipitation 90%.
40 hours <i>Forecast 2 of 7</i>	Tuesday, January 9 th 12:00pm	Winter storm watch in effect from Wednesday evening through Thursday evening. Snow likely. Snow accumulations 2-3 inches. Highs in the low 30s. Chance of precipitation 90%.
32 hours <i>Forecast 3 of 7</i>	Tuesday, January 9 th 8:00pm	Winter storm watch in effect from Wednesday evening through Thursday evening. Rain and snow in the morning then rain likely in the afternoon. Snow accumulation 2 inches. Highs in the mid 30s. Chance of precipitation 80%.
24 hours <i>Forecast 4 of 7</i>	Wednesday, January 10 th 4:00am	Winter weather advisory in effect from 7pm this evening to 2pm Thursday afternoon. Snow likely in the morning then rain in the afternoon. Snow accumulation 1 inch. Highs in the mid 30s. Chance of precipitation 80%.
16 hours <i>Forecast 5 of 7</i>	Wednesday, January 10 th 12:00pm	Winter weather advisory in effect from 7pm this evening to 2pm Thursday afternoon. Snow mixed with rain in the morning then rain in the afternoon. Snow accumulation less than 1 inch. Highs in the mid 30s. Chance of precipitation 90%.

Winter Weather Challenge 6DMS

8 hours <i>Forecast 6 of 7</i>	Wednesday, January 10 th 8:00pm	Winter weather advisory canceled. Rain likely heavy at times. High in the mid 30s. Rainfall accumulation of 1 to 2 inches expected. Chance of rain 100%.
Decision Must Be Made <i>Forecast 7 of 7</i>	Thursday, January 11 th 4:00am	Rain likely. High in the upper 30s. Rainfall accumulation of less than 1 inch. Chance of rain 100%.
